



Frequently Asked Questions

Do I need to register for GroupLink?

It's highly recommended as space fills quickly. Registering for GroupLink help us plan for the event. But if you forget, please still come. We just want you to come and get connected. If you can, let us know you're coming by visiting the [GroupLink page](#), and clicking the registration link.

What if I can't attend GroupLink?

If any of the groups that form at GroupLink aren't full, we'd love to help you get connected. We'll post a list of groups with openings a couple days after the event. If one of the groups matches your stage of life and area of town, and is meeting on a night of the week that works for you, you can request to join that group. Open group listings are active for 3-4 weeks after GroupLink. Openings are filled on a first-come, first-served basis.

What is the difference between GroupLink and a Connect Group?

You go to GroupLink, a one-time event, to join a connect group. Connect groups are small groups of 10-14 people that meet weekly in someone's home for fellowship, Bible study, and prayer.

What is a Connector/Assimilator?

Volunteers serve a vital role at each GroupLink event. Connectors/Assimilators are volunteers who help people connect into groups by providing information about Connect Groups. They also attend GroupLink to assist people as they form groups. They will be wearing blue t-shirts at the event.

Is childcare provided at GroupLink?

Childcare will be provided. Please RSVP on the registration form if you need childcare because space is limited.
