BOTTOM LINE: Celebrate lost people coming to know Jesus through Crossroads!

(CARD 1) ICEBREAKER QUESTION:

AROUND THE ROOM: When is it okay to start listening to Christmas music and put up decorations? November 1? Day after thanksgiving? What's your tradition?

Have someone pray to begin your group time.

(CARD 2) HISTORICAL/GETTING TO KNOW YOU:

AROUND THE ROOM: What was your best birthday? What made it so special?

A FEW OF YOU: How does your family celebrate a momentous occasion?

AROUND THE ROOM: What has been your favorite memory at Crossroads?

BIBLICAL:

Leader: On Sunday, we celebrated Crossroads' 48th birthday! For 48 years, God has been doing amazing things through our church! Now more than ever, our mission is to "connect people to God and one another!"

(CARD 3) AROUND THE ROOM: What did you take away from Sunday's message?

A FEW OF YOU: What is the mission of our church? (Reaching lost people for Jesus!)

(CARD 4)A FEW OF YOU: What part do you play in fulfilling the mission of our church?

A FEW OF YOU: What is the theme of Luke 15? (The lost being found.)

AROUND THE ROOM: How do you relate to the prodigal son in the story?

(CARD 5) AROUND THE ROOM: What happens when we are like the older brother, judging sinners as they come back to God?

A FEW OF YOU: Why is it sometimes difficult to accept a sinner repenting and giving their life to Jesus? (They're too far gone, they've committed worse sins than my own, holding on to our own grudges, etc.)

Someone: Read Luke 15:20-24

AROUND THE ROOM: How does the father celebrate the return of his son? (kissed him, brought the best robe, put a ring on his finger, sandles on his feet, prepared a feast, had a party)

(CARD 6) Someone: Read Luke 15:4-7

A FEW OF YOU: What is heavens response to a sinner repenting? What should ours be?

A FEW OF YOU: Why does each sheep/person matter to the shepherd/God?

(CARD 7) APPLICATION:

A FEW OF YOU: How can you get more involved and fulfill the mission at Crossroads?

AROUND THE ROOM: How can you help celebrate with people who come to Jesus?

A FEW OF YOU: What can you do to lead more people to Jesus?

(CARD 8) PRAYER:

(Make sure to take prayer requests before closing.)

- -Pray that you will remain faithful to God's mission for your life!
- -Pray that God would continue to use our church to do incredible things!
