

- Use only power adapters authorized by the Division.

- If the adapter power cord or plug is damaged, it must be repaired by the manufacturer or a similarly qualified person.
- Check the battery pack for signs of damage or leakage before each use. Do not charge a damaged or leaking battery pack.
- Before charging, make sure the charging port is dry.
- Do not cover your robot while charging, as this may cause the components to overheat.
- Do not run your robot outside of water as this may cause it to overheat
- Only a certified professional should disassemble your sealed driving kit.
- Do not operate your pool cleaning robot and pool filter at the same time.
- The oil seal around the motor contains grease and may cause significant water contamination if the motor is damaged. If you think there is a leak, stop using the unit immediately.
- Do not squeeze or disassemble the battery pack. Do not heat the battery pack or place it near any heat source
- Do not crush or disassemble the robot.






#### **Key Description**



#### (I) Power button

- Short press the power on button to turn on.
- · Long press to turn off

#### Display light description

- When working, the blue light is fixed.
- When the power is low, the red light is fixed.
- When charging, there is will a breathing green light.
- When fully charged, the green light is fixed.
- When encountering abnormalities, the red light is flashing.

#### **PRODUCT OPERATION**


#### Operation

**Note:** This robot is best used in an environment where the water temperature is 50-95°F (10-35°C), pH: 7.0-7.4, chlorine: max 4 ppm, NaCl: max 5000 ppm.


a. Press and hold the power button until the indicator light comes on and beeps.




b. Please place the bottom of the robot facing the wall and gently place it into the water.



c. When the robot runs to low power, it will automatically stop next to the pool wall



d. Use the floating ball connected to the robot to pull your robot out of the water.



### Charging


Before charging, please check that the charging terminals are dry and clean.





## Clean the filter cover and robot chassis


a. Open the fixed clips at the front and rear of the robot.




 Gently pull the plates on both sides of the housing outward in order to remove the housing, and then remove the plate.



c. Empty the trash from the chassis and rinse the chassis and filter cover with water.



d. After cleaning, please put the robot back together completely.



#### Replace the brushes


If the brushes are worn out, follow the steps below.

a. Remove the housing of your robot and locate the brushes.





b. Using a small tool or your fingers, push the two small latches to either side.



 c. Press the top of the suction port brushes on both sides and push the suction port brushes out.



d. Finally, insert the new suction port brushes into the bottom slot of the robot.


#### Replace the wheels


If your robot's wheels break, follow the steps below.

a. Remove the housing of your robot and locate the location of the broken wheel.



 Using a tool or your finger, gently push out toward the slot and push out the robot chassis by pressing on the top of the old wheel.





c. Take out the new wheel, first aligning the two fixed ends on the wheel with the hollow under the robot chassis. Then press gently and if the installation is successful, you will hear a "click".
