

BEFORE MEASURING YOUR RING CONFIRM PRINT SCALING 100%


CHECK THE PRINT SIZE OF THIS RING CHART



- 1. Selecting an accurate ring size comes from a very precise measurement. Follow these instructions carefully to ensure you are taking an accurate measurement.
- 2. Prior to printing this page check your print settings. Ensure the scaling is set to **100%** or **'NONE'** in the dialog box.
- 3. **Measure the bars to the left**. It must be exactly 1 inch or 30 mm long. If this is not accurate check your print settings and reprint this page.

MEASURE YOUR CURRENT RING

- 1. Select a ring that properly fits your finger.
- 2. Place the ring over the circles below, matching the inside edge of the ring to the circle nearest in size. The measurement refers to the diameter of the ring.
- 3. If the ring falls between two sizes order the half size.



MEASUREMENTS SHOULD MATCH THE INSIDE EDGE OF YOUR RING

size 8 18.1mm .713 inches size 9 19.0mm .748 inches

size 10 19.8mm .780 inches size 11 20.6mm .811 inches

size 12 21.4mm .843 inches
