

Ring Size Converter

Before measuring your ringsize, be sure this guide is printed in A4 international paper-size. You can check the accuracy of your print by checking the size of the measurements below:



To find your Overload ring size, you can use an existing ring that fits you well. Match the inside of that ring with one of the circles below. When your ring has been placed on the right size, you should only see the white circle - with no background color - inside your ring. If your ideal size falls between two circles, we recommend choosing a half size.

Please note that this converter is a guideline and the outcome may vary due to differences in measurement methods. If you are not sure about your size after using the converter, please get your size measured at your local jewelry store.
