

ALTO Stair Treads from Liza Phillips Design

ALTO Stair Treads are like individual rugs for your steps that answer the dilemma of what to do with those open stairways, or how to minimally accent beautiful wood steps without hiding the risers. Artist and designer, Liza Phillips, is the innovator of these clever little carpets available in four color sets. Her line also includes optional coordinating mats for the top and bottom stair landings.

Tai Ping

From high-end Park Avenue residences to prestigious hotels and casinos, Tai Ping is known globally for their dazzling designs in custom carpet. Residential offerings include Fu III from the Fret Collection, a latticework design influenced by Chinese architectural elements that requires hand-tufting, hand-knotting and needlepoint to complete. The intricacy of Marquis I in the Reminiscence Collection is inspired by 18th century Versailles and features a classic lacework effect that appears to sit delicately atop the field of the carpet. Each year Tai Ping releases two major collections and three smaller collections for the residential market.
