PINOT NOIR 2011

T.A. 6.0 g/l

Alcohol 13.0% VOL

Harvest 22.0-24.0°Brix

The deep red colour of our 2011 Pinot noir is both promising and exciting in its appearance. An inviting and rather deep nose with toffee, black tea, Christmas lilies and dark berry fruit is a preamble for the complex wine to follow. A shy and velvety entrance gives way to ripe fruit such as cassis and cherries. Salivating acidity, transparent and soft leather-like tannins combined with cassia bark and Brazil nut characters show great depth and potential for longevity. This is still a very closed and youthful wine which we expect will show great stamina in the cellar.
