PINOT NOIR 2010

pH 3.65

T.A. 5.8 g/L

R.S. < 2.0g/l

Alcohol 13.0% VOL

Harvest 23.0°Brix

The colour is a rich red shade with a purple hue. The nose is both pretty and varietal with subtle undertones of briarwood and new leather. Fine tannins spread across the palate giving a subtle and silken texture to the wine which tastes of black cherries, black forest berries, freshly grated cacao chocolate and sweet tobacco, all underpinned by Christmas cake spices. The palate is slightly restrained and decanting is recommended before serving.
