Mean overall acceptance angle: 28.8° Class: R 12 [HIGH]

MRC - MEASUREMENT OF LUMINANCE REFLECTANCE (LRV)

• Stainless Steel - Mill Finish: 42.2

(45% Luminance contrast with surrounding substrate required).

- Installation utilises our 5mm thick rubber drilling templates with laser cut holes at the required 50mm centres.
- If masonry drilling carpet over concrete, it may be possible to drill directly through the carpet without snagging it. Performing a test on a scrap piece of carpet is recommended. If snagging occurs it will be necessary to hole punch the carpet prior to drilling.
- 8mm diameter holes are drilled approx. 20mm deep.
- The holes are vacuumed free of drilling debris.
- Individual Tactile Indicators are hammered down flush with the substrate using a nylon mallet, leaving the surrounding carpet visible.
