Grenache 'Sciurbí' vineyard overlooks the Mediterranean Sea.

It's a surprisingly full-bodied wine with floral aromas after ageing for one year.

This wine dispels the myth that Liguria is a land of only white wines!

COLOUR

Intense ruby with purple and garnet hues.

BOUQUET

Cherry jam, sultanas, blackberries in the first year. Complex notes of tobacco and cocoa evolve over time.

PALATE

Heady and intense, balanced, persistent, gentle tannins.

SOIL TYPE

Loam, clay, bulky calcareous soil.

EXPOSITION

South, south-west.

CULTIVATION SYSTEM

Spurred cordon.

HARVEST TIME

Last ten days of September/early October.

VINIFICATION AND AGEING

Maceration for 15 days on the skins.

Fermentation 20-25 days in steel tanks.

Aged 12 months in steel tanks and 4 months in the bottle.
