THE BUILDING

The Gallery was designed to create an ideal environment for exhibiting works in wood and other media. It was built in 1994 from Australian materials: Jarrah posts, beams and staircase; Tasmanian Oak floors; ebonised Victorian Ash window and door frames; and New South Wales Flooded Gum wall panelling.

The Gallery is exclusively the home of Wood Works Design products from Gallery director David Mac Laren and master wood turner Jim Homann.

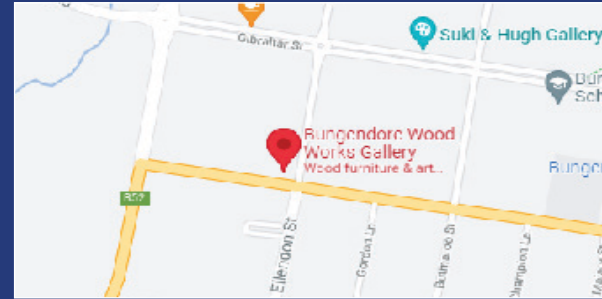
WHY A GALLERY IN BUNGENDORE?
