

Grants Research Intern Position Description

<u>Kits to Heart</u> is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization with a mission to bring smiles and solidarity to those affected by cancer. Founded in May 2020 in Clarksville, MD by a three-time cancer survivor, Kits to Heart promotes a vision to provide adequate material and psychosocial support for a better treatment process.

We seek a bright, energetic individual to join our team as a Grants Research Intern to grow and expand the meaningful work of Kits to Heart. This will be a fantastic opportunity to gain experience in grants research; learn first-hand what it is like to work for a young and growing nonprofit; and help your community. Interns will work closely with the Founder and Executive Director, Sonia Su. The intern may start as early as May 2024, with a minimum six-month commitment and the possibility of an extension.

The Grants Research Intern's duties will include, but are not limited to:

- Research and identify potential funding sources, such as donors, grants, in-kind donations, sponsorships, and fundraising opportunities at individual, foundation, and corporate levels
- Organize opportunities in Google Drive
- Assist in the development of event planning and programming, including fundraisers and partnerships with schools and like-minded organizations
- Perform other duties, as assigned

Preferred Qualifications and Experience:

- High school diploma or equivalent
- Located in Maryland, but not required
- Interest and aptitude for working in the nonprofit field
- Passionate about helping to improve the quality of life of patients affected by cancer and contribute to our mission
- Strong organizational, communication, and interpersonal skills
- Detail-oriented and able to prioritize
- Ability to multitask and work independently

Hours & Stipend:

3 to 5 hours per week, with biweekly 20-minute Zoom check-in meetings. Minimum six-month commitment with a \$500 stipend upon successful completion.
