Message from the Founder Sonia Su



Entering 2023, I knew it would be an eventful year. After launching Art for Cancer Wellness in 2022 and our weekend volunteers assembling 70+ cancer care kits on New Year's Eve, the momentum was strong for Kits to Heart—and myself.

In March, I welcomed my first baby right before turning the big 3-0. It also marked four years since my last cancer treatment. While my personal life was certainly keeping me busy, our volunteers and I continued with our mission.

We are proud to have distributed 2,560 care kits in 2023, making a total of 7,300 care kits distributed since we started in 2020. I am very thankful to the selfless volunteers who dedicated 23,280+ service hours in 2023. In fact, 6,000+ volunteers have contributed 67,000+ hours since we started our efforts in 2020.

Thanks also to the continued support from the United Way of Central Maryland, we provided 103

free Art for Cancer Wellness workshops, totaling 200+ workshops to 180+ patients, caregivers, and oncology healthcare workers.

In 2023, I was named **40 Under 40 in Cancer** and one of 10 **L'Oréal Paris Women of Worth**. The latter was an unforgettable experience, from filming videos that aired on HBO Max to celebrating in Los Angeles with fellow honorees and our MVP—my dad, Mike! Inviting him to the celebration was an honor, since he has given so much of himself to support us, including making most of the **58 care kit and blanket deliveries in 2023!**

Financial Overview

In 2023, Kits to Heart was fortunate enough to receive a \$10,000 Neighborhood Grant from the United Way of Central Maryland in Q1 to continue to support our Art for Cancer Wellness Program.

The L'Oréal Paris' Women of Worth award came with a generous \$25,000 grant in Q4.

We also received an increase in year-end donations from our strong community of supporters.

Kits to Heart is deeply grateful for all the support and plans to continue fundraising to sustain and grow our efforts.


