2021 Adelaide Hills Pinot Grigio

Region

The Adelaide Hills is located in the Mount Lofty Ranges, east of Adelaide. One of the largest geographical wine regions in Australia, its diversity in terms of altitude, climate and soil helps it produce its distinctive cool climate wines.

Vintage

2021 vintage was one of the greats. Excellent winter/spring rainfall, sunny warm spring followed by one of the mildest summers on record with only one day over 36 and beautiful mild evenings. Whites are incredibly fragrant, aromatic with delicious fresh acidity and lovely fleshy fruit palates.

Wine

It's a simple winemaking process where the fruit does all the work for you! Fruit for this wine was crushed and gently pressed, juice was clarified, and a small percentage was sent to old barrel to add texture and complexity.

A bright, fresh, fruit driven wine style. It's a typical Pinot Grigio, aromatic, fresh and crisp. Deliciously delicate aromas of stone fruit & honeysuckle with a palate of baked apple and pear.
