Kingdom Hearts Gummiphone Tutorial

Materials: A red case that fits your phone

Fabric choices - In order of durability

Craft Felt (glue two sheets to make it thicker) Stiffened Craft Felt (already stiff) Fleece (Strengthen with fusible interfacing) Faux Leather

Real Leather

Hot Glue or Silicone adhesive (if case is silicone based) Pattern

Pattern Note:

The pattern is sized for a Google Pixel 2 phone (5.7x2.7x0.3 inch, 145.7x69.7x7.8 mm). The pattern can be enlarged or shrunk as needed to fit your phone.

Fabric Note:

If you plan on using this more as a prop, craft felt, thick felt, or fleece strengthened with fusible interfacing will work fine. If you plan on using it as a daily case, use stronger fabric such as leather or faux leather (altho this tends to peel), or use good quality felt/fleece.

1. Cut out the paper pattern.

2. Cut the pattern pieces out of the fabric. Be sure to cut the larger pieces first before the smaller parts.

3. Assemble the parts together and carefully glue together. To ensure each piece goes where it should, dab a small bit of glue to hold it into place before gluing further. CAUTION: Hot glue is HOT! If it gets anywhere, use a napkin or towel to clean it off, DO NOT USE YOUR FINGERS! It will stick to you and BURN.

4. Carefully arrange the pieces on the red case. Shift the pieces around if there is a fingerprint or other phone sensors. If the crown part is blocking the camera, cut the crown line hole bigger. Take your time, glue slowly and a little at a time to ensure the pieces align properly.

5. Check if it needs more glue by gently lifting the edges of the pattern pieces. Hot glue dries quickly, your new Kingdom Hearts phone case is ready!
