The 2015 Chardonnay "Pheasant Hill Vineyard - Block 1A, Rows 1-32" is a solid Chard, showing reasonable depth for a wine that is a year older than most current releases (and from a site that tends to produce elegance), plus the anticipated acidity and a certain amount of cream. It was aged for nine months in neutral French oak. The wood is easily controlled and subsumed, while the finish lingers nicely. This is understated—the region is not usually about fat and big—but it has good substance and seems like a small step up on the 2014. Overall, it is lovely. It may hold up to a decade, but let's take that in stages. There were 154 cases produced.
