Dear Gary

Sorry that I've taken so long to get back to you about the Astec roofing treatment that Tile Brite applied to our home. Since the compound was applied to the roof, at the beginning of last winter, there haven't been too many hot days to see if it works.

I can cheerfully say that after last week, when the temperature went into the 40's for most of the day and dropped to  $25^{\rm O}$  at night, the house was still comfortable to live in. We don't have an air conditioner but the ceiling fans were more than enough to make the house pleasant when it was very hot outside. Even with the ceiling batts installed (three years ago) , the house still became unbearable when the outside temperature reached  $38^{\rm O}$  for more than a few hours. The difference was definitely noticeable.

I've also had the misfortune to have to work in the roof space on warm days and the longest that I could last up there was I 0 minutes at a time, before the heat became dangerous. It's still hot up there, but I can now stay a lot longer, and complete the job without de-hydrating.

As far as the cold weather goes, I'm not sure. as we have a combustion heater going and this winter was a lot milder than previous ones. The gutters that your company installed work as advertised and the roof doesn't leak any more. The roof certainly looks the best that it's ever done, it's over 40 years old and looks 'almost new'.

We certainly don't need any more persuasion that the Astec treatment works and is a worthwhile investment, even for the temperate Adelaide climate.
