

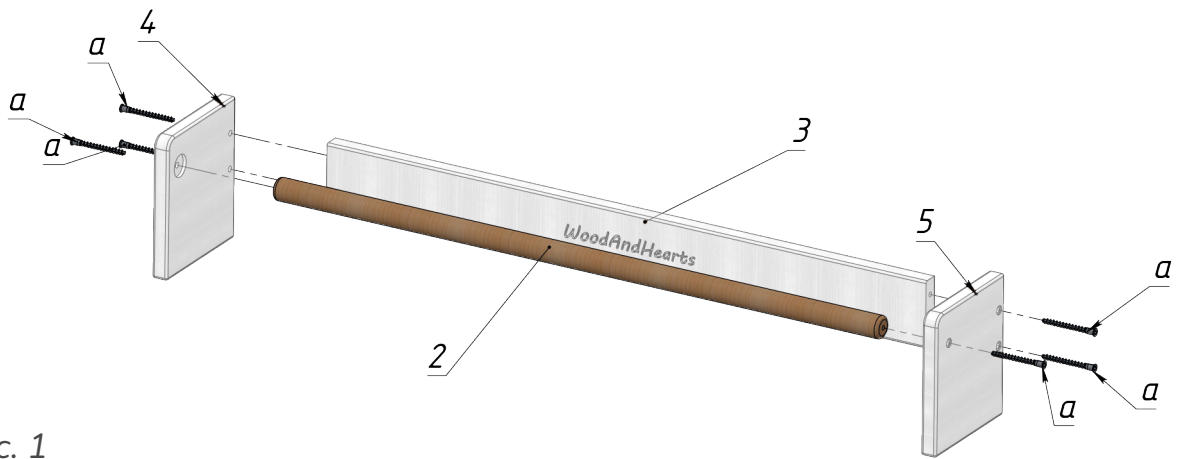


Montessori Small Wall Shelf



ASSEMBLY DETAILS

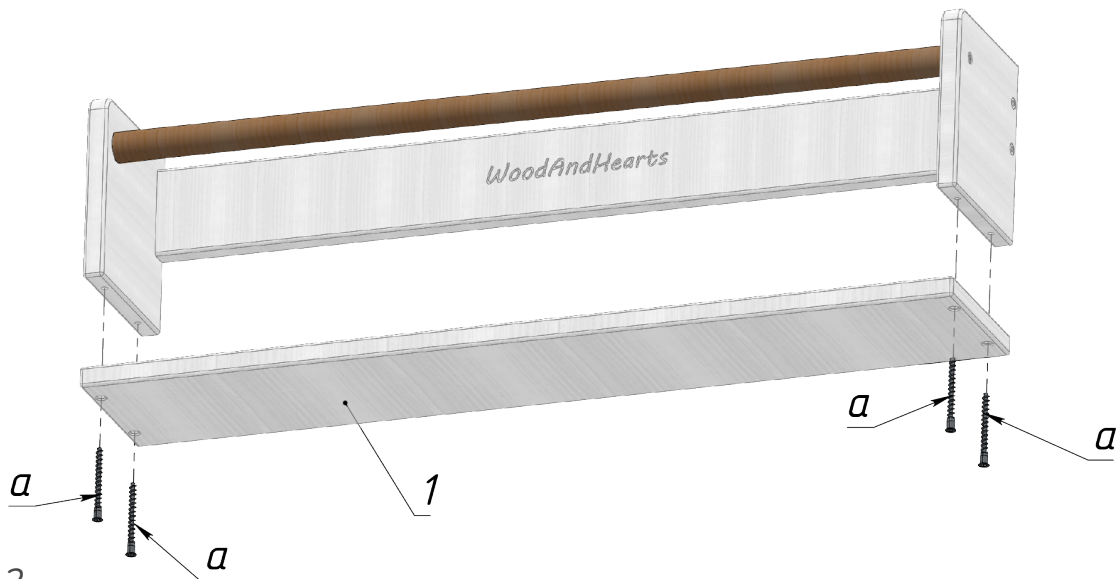
<p>1 - Base</p> <p>1 pc.</p>	<p>2 - Nog</p> <p>1 pc.</p>	<p>3 - Back plank</p> <p>1 pc.</p>	<p>4 - Left sidewall</p> <p>1 pc.</p>
<p>5 - Right sidewall</p> <p>1 pc.</p>	<p>a - 5x40 Confirmat screw</p> <p>10 pcs.</p>	<p>b - 3 mm Hex key</p> <p>1 pc.</p>	<p>c - Plastic dowel</p> <p>2 pcs.</p>
<p>d - Plasterboard dowel</p> <p>2 pcs.</p>	<p>e - Self-tapping screw 6x60mm</p> <p>2 pcs.</p>		



Pic. 1

Take the left sidewall (4) and using the confirmat screw (a) and hex key (b), attach the nog (2) and back plank (3). Depending on the position of the detail 3, the usage type of the shelf differ. See the main picture on the page 1.

Then attach the right sidewall (5) in a similar way. See Pic.1.



Pic. 2

Take the confirmat screws (a) and hex key (b) and attach the base (1) to the previously assembled construction. See Pic.2.

To hook a shelf on the brick wall, take self-tapping screws (e) and dowels (c). If you have a drywall wall, use other dowels (d).
