




Solid swedish ladder



ASSEMBLY DETAILS



Take the Right sidewall (2) and using screws a and hex key b, connect the long nogs (6) to it. See Pic. $\bf 1$




Take the Left sidewall (1) and attach it to the previously assembled construction with screws a. See Pic. 2



Attach the lintels (3) to the construction using the confirmat screws (c) and hex key b. See Pic. 3






Take the right sidewall of the pull-up bar (5) and using the screws a and a hex key b, attach the short nogs (7) to it. See Pic. 4

Take the left sidewall of the pull-up bar (4) and using the screws a and a hex key b, connect it to the previously assembled construction. See Pic. 5









Install the pull-up bar on the swedish ladder. See Pic. 6

To be used under direct supervision of an adult only.


Always be vigilant during children's games.

Fasten the assembled Swedish Ladder to the wooden frame using self-tapping screw (e). See Pic. 7



Fasten the assembled Swedish Ladder to the wooden frame using the dowel (d) and self-tapping screw e. See Pic. 8
