

3 EASY STEPS TO FIND THE LOCK HANDING

Step 1: Look at your gate from the outside (secure side) or visualize it if the gate is yet to be installed.

Step 2: Determine if your hinges are on the left- or right-hand side of the gate.

Step 3: The side that your hinges are on equals the lock handing. For example, if your gate hinges are on the right, you will need a right-hand lock (and vice versa).





For some of our locks, we offer a right-handed or a left-handed version and the lock handing you choose depends on whether your gate is right or left-hand hung. Depending on how your gate is installed, you will need either a right- or a left-handed lock to ensure the keypad is on the outside when fitted. If you choose the wrong lock handing, you will end up with a lock that has a handle on the outside, allowing anyone to enter.

To avoid this, you need to find out the correct lock handing and we are here to help.
