

HOW TO: MEASURE YOUR RING SIZE

Before printing: Make sure that this page is scaled to 100% and printed on A4 size paper.

If the line on the right matches the width of your credit card, you're good to go!

Method 1: measure an existing ring

- 1. Pick a ring of your own that fits well
- 2. Check which circle beneath matches the size of your ring. Make sure that the black circle is only visible within the ring.
- 3. If the ring is in between two circles (sizes) it depends on the thickness of the ring which size you should pick. Going for a thin design? We recommend the smaller size. If you're going for a normal to thick design, we recommend the larger size.



Method 2: Measure without a ring

Cut out the sizer and cut the beige line. Pull the end (right side) through the opening until the paper fits around your finger, quite tight. You can now read the ring size at the beige line.



Still don't know your ring size?

Take a ruler and measure the diameter of the ring (do not include the edges, so just the inside of the ring). The number of millimeters is your needed ring size, visible in the circles above. Or go to the size chart on our website.
