

LET'S GET MAKING

Tool kit

1 cone of WATG's Jersey Be Good yarn in colour A

1 cone of WATG's Jersey Be Good yarn in colour B

1 trigger ring

2 mini clips

1 sewing needle

This pattern has instructions for 3 styles of Keyring - the Four Strand Square Braid, the Half Square Knot Braid and the Alternating Half Hitch Braid.

SIZES

The actual dimensions of your jewellery will depend on your individual tension. All 3 styles of the Alicia Keyring are designed to be the same size.


Width: Approx. 1.5cm/0.5"

Length (braided section): Approx. 9cm/3.5"

Length (total): Approx. 19cm/7.5"

All macrame techniques can be found at the back of the pattern.

HOW TO MAKE YOUR FOUR STRAND SQUARE BRAID

- Start by cutting 2 strands of Jersey Be Good, each 100cm/39.5" long.
- Take your 2 strands and pass them through one of your mini clips until the strands are folded equally in half. You now have 4 strands to work with.
- Repeat the instructions for working a **four strand square braid** until your keyring measures 9cm/3.5".
- 4 Take one of your strands and wrap it tightly around the other 3 strands. Thread the strand through your needle, then take the needle under the wrapped section to secure it.
- 5 Cut your strands 10cm/4" below the end of your square braid.

HOW TO MAKE YOUR HALF SQUARE KNOT BRAID

- Start by cutting 2 strands of Jersey Be Good, one 150cm/39.5" long and one 50cm/19.5".
- 2 Fold the shorter strand in half, pass the loop end through one of your mini clip and thread the 2 loose ends through the loop to secure it.
- 3 Take the longer strand and lay it horizontally underneath the two strands coming from the mini clip.
- Work a series of half square knots until your keyring measures 9cm/3.5".
- Take one of your strands and wrap it tightly around the other 3 strands. Thread the strand through your needle, then take the needle under the wrapped section to secure it.
- 6 Cut your strands 10cm/4" below the end of your braid.

HOW TO MAKE YOUR ALTERNATING HALF HITCH BRAID


- Start by cutting 2 strands of Jersey Be Good 100cm/39.5" long, 1 strand in colour A and the other in colour B.
- Take your 2 strands and pass them through your trigger ring, you now have 4 strands to work with. Pull the middle 2 strands through so they measure 25cm.
- Repeat the instructions for working an **alternating half hitch braid** until your keyring measures 9cm/3.5".
- 4 Take one of your strands and wrap it tightly around the other 3 strands. Thread the strand through your needle, then take the needle under the wrapped section to secure it.
- 5 Cut your strands 10cm/4" below the end of your braid.

PRESENTING THE KNOTS


Your keyrings are created using a variety of knot techniques. Here's how to make each one!


ALTERNATING HALF HITCH

- 1 Lay your 4 strands vertically. The two strands in the centre will form the middle of your braid and the two strands on the outside will be your working strands.
- Take the working strand on the left and pass it over and then under the middle strands and out through the loop formed on the left.
- 3 Take the working strand on the right and pass it over and then under the middle strands and out through the loop formed on the right.
- 4 Repeat steps 2 and 3 alternating between the left and and right sides.






FOUR STRAND SQUARE BRAID


- 1 Lay 4 strands to from a cross shape. Working clockwise from the strand pointing straight up, letter your strands A, B, C and D.
- 2 Fold strand A down and over strand B.
- 3 Fold strand B over strands A and C and fold strand C over strands B and D.
- Fold strand D over strand C and then through the first loop created by strand A.
- 5 Gently pull the end of each of the strands to tighten the knot.
- Now, working anti-clockwise from the strand pointing straight up, re-letter your strands A, B, C and D.
- 7 Repeat steps 2 to 5, this time working in the opposite direction.
- 8 Repeat steps 2 to 7 to create your braid.

TOP TIP: To create a vertical stripe in your braid, use 1 colour for strands A and C and another colour for strands B and D.



HALF SQUARE KNOT


- Bring A from right to left, over the middle strands and under B.
- 2 Now bring B under the two middle strands and through the loop formed by A.
- 3 Pull on both A and B to tighten them you have now made one half square knot. B is now on the right, and A is on the left.
- 4 To make the next knot, bring B from right to left over the middle strands and under A.
- 5 Bring A under the middle strands and through the loop of B. Pull as before to finish off the knot it should sit snugly against the previous one. As you work, your knots will form a twisting pattern. Make sure you always start your knots with the strand on the right-hand side.
