

Celebration - Block 12

Finished Block Size: 8 1/2" x 8 1/2"

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

Please read all instructions before beginning. All Fabrics used in the sample quilt come from French General's Atelier de France fabric line by Moda Fabrics and are based on fabrics that are 44/45" wide.

TO AVOID CUTTING ERRORS, IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT YOU READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE CUTTING FABRICS.

As in all quilting, it is essential that you achieve a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance in order for your quilt to go together smoothly. It is recommended that you carefully measure a sample seam before beginning any assembly so that you achieve it. To aid in the easy assembly, measurements of the quilt in progress are given through-out this pattern.

Please note that when instructions are given to "join" one unit to another, it is highly recommended that you pin before sewing. This helps ensure accuracy of your blocks and gives a nice appearance to your piecing.

Unless otherwise noted all seam allowance are $\frac{1}{4}$ ". WOF/LOF = Width/Length of Fabric

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

From Fabric 12558-20

Cut four (4) 4" squares.

From Fabric 13806-12

• Cut four (4) 4" squares.

From Fabric 13808-15

• Cut eight (8) 1" x 1 ½" rectangles, eight (8) 1 ½" x 1" rectangles, four (4) 1" x 2" rectangles and eight (8) 1 ½" squares.

From Fabric 13802-12

• Cut four (4) 2 ½" x 1 ½" rectangles.

From Fabric 12558-13

• Cut eight (8) 1 ½" squares.


From Fabric 13802-15

• Cut one (1) 3 ½" square.


BLOCK 12 ASSEMBLY:

Pay attention to the fabric directions throughout the assembly of this block.


- 1. Assemble (32) HST according to the direction on pages 5-6 with (4) 4" squares of 12558-20 and (4) squares of 13806-12 fabrics. Press and trim the HST units to measure 1 ½" square.
- 2. Assemble (16) HST according to the directions on pages 5-6 with (8) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " squares of 13808-15 and 12558-13 fabrics. Press and trim the HST units to measure 1" square.
- 3. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " HST on top of another HST to make (1) Unit 1 (Diagram 1). Repeat to make (4) Unit 1 strips.
- 4. Sew (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " HST on top of another HST to make (1) Unit 2 (Diagram 2). Repeat to make (4) Unit 2 strips.
- 5. Sew (1) Unit 1 strip to the left side of (1) 2 ½" x 1 ½" 13802-12 rectangle. Sew (1) Unit 2 strip to the right side of the rectangle to make (1) Unit 3 rectangle (Diagram 3). Repeat to make (4) Unit 3 rectangles.
- 6. Sew together (4) 1" HSTs and (1) 1" x 1 ½" 13808-15 rectangle to make (1) Unit 4 rectangle (Diagram 4). Repeat to make (4) Unit 4 rectangles total.
- 7. Sew (1) Unit 4 rectangle to the bottom of (1) Unit 3 rectangle to make (1) Unit 5 rectangle (Diagram 5). Repeat to make (4) Unit 5 rectangles total.




- 8. Sew (1) 1 ½" HST to the left side of (1) 1 ½" x 1" 13808-15 rectangle to make the top row. Sew (1) 1 ½" HST to the right side of (1) 1 ½" x 1" 13808-15 rectangle to make the bottom row. Sew the top row, (1) 1" x 2" 13808-15 rectangle and the bottom row together to make (1) Unit 6 rectangle (Diagram 6). Repeat to make (2) Unit 6 rectangles total.
- 9. Sew (1) 1 ½" HST on top of a second HST. Sew (1) 1" x 1 ½" 13808-15 strip to the top of the sewn unit to make (1) Unit 7 rectangle (Diagram 7). Repeat to make (2) Unit 7 rectangles total.
- 10. Sew (1) Unit 6 rectangle to the left side of (1) Unit 7 rectangle to make (1) Unit 8 square (Diagram 8). Repeat to make (2) Unit 8 squares total.



- 11. Sew (1) 1 ½" HST on top of a second HST. Sew (1) 1" x 1 ½" 13808-15 strip to the top of the sewn unit to make (1) Unit 9 rectangle (Diagram 9). Repeat to make (2) Unit 9 rectangles total.
- 12. Sew (1) 1 ½" HST to the right side of (1) 1 ½" x 1" 13808-15 rectangle to make the top row. Sew (1) 1 ½" HST to the left side of (1) 1 ½" x 1" 13808-15 rectangle to make the bottom row. Sew the top row, (1) 1" x 2" 13808-15 rectangle and the bottom row together to make (1) Unit 10 rectangle (Diagram 10). Repeat to make (2) Unit 10 rectangles total.
- 13. Sew (1) Unit 9 rectangle to the left side of (1) Unit 10 rectangle to make (1) Unit 11 square (Diagram 11). Repeat to make (2) Unit 11 squares total.



- 14. Refer to the Block Layout and sew (1) Unit 8 square to the left side of (1) Unit 5 rectangle. Sew (1) Unit 11 square to the right side of the Unit 5 rectangle to make the top row. Sew (1) Unit 5 rectangle to each side of (1) 3 ½"
 - 13802-15 square to make the middle row. Sew (1) Unit 11 square to the left side of (1) Unit 5 rectangle. Sew (1) Unit 8 square to the right side of the Unit 5 rectangle to make the bottom row. Sew the rows together to make the 8 ½" x 8 ½" Block 12 square.
