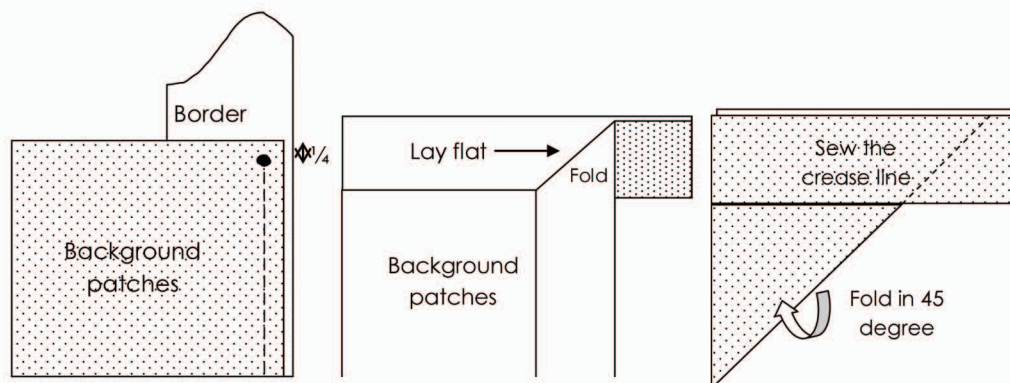


Haute Bohemian Errata

- From each stripe cut a 21 1/2" strip for the Center Square Border.
- Set aside the remainder of each of the four (4) LOF strips for Border 6.
- Also, set aside the wider light strips for later use in Border 5.
- With right sides together, center and sew a Navy Stripe Fabric E 3 3/4" x 21 1/2" strip to the Gold Floral Fabric F 14" square along one edge. Repeat with the remaining three (3) 3 3/4" x 21 1/2" strips border strips.
- Fold each of the four (4) LOF border strips in half length-wise and mark the center with a pin. (Diagram 2)
- Pin one (1) strip to the left side of the Center Square, matching the center of the Border Strip to the center of the Square.
- Start sewing 1/4" from the corner along one border side, and stop 1/4" before the other corner. Repeat this process until all four borders are attached.
- Lay one of the border strips flat and fold the other strip in a 45-degree angle. Press well. Pin the border in place, taking care to make sure that each of your corners comes together as a mirror image.
- Unfold the border (and re-pin if necessary) to sew on the crease. Trim the mitered seam allowance to 1/4" and then press open.
- Repeat this process until all four corners are sewn and pressed.
- Your center should now measure 20 1/2" including seam allowances.

From the Red Paisley Fabric B cut:

- 2 - 15" squares for the Setting Triangles. Using the 45 degree diagonal grid lines on your cutting mat and ruler carefully cut diagonally from the upper left corner to the bottom right corner of the squares. You will now have 4 half-square triangles. (Diagram 3 on Page 4)
- Sew a Red Paisley 15" half-square triangle to each side of the Center Medallion unit.
- Sew the two (2) remaining Red Paisley 15" half-square triangles to the top & bottom of the Center Medallion unit. (Diagram 4 on Page 4)
- Your Center Medallion should measure 28 3/4" including seam allowances.
