USING FRENCH GENERAL'S ANTOINETTE COLLECTION

Quilt Size: 59" x 74"

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

Please read all instructions before beginning. All Fabrics used in the sample quilt come from French General's Antoinette fabric line by Moda Fabrics and are based on fabrics that are 44/45" wide.

TO AVOID CUTTING ERRORS, IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT YOU READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE CUTTING FABRICS.

As in all quilting, it is essential that you achieve a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance in order for your quilt to go together smoothly. It is recommended that you carefully measure a sample seam before beginning any assembly so that you achieve it. To aid in the easy assembly, measurements of the quilt in progress are given through-out this pattern.

Please note that when instructions are given to "join" one unit to another, it is highly recommended that you pin before sewing. This helps ensure accuracy of your blocks and gives a nice appearance to your piecing.

Unless otherwise noted all seam allowance are $\frac{1}{4}$ ". WOF/LOF = Width/Length of Fabric

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

Fabric A – Flower Blocks - Cream (Colorway #1)

Fabric A – Flower Blocks - Blue (Colorway #2)

Fabric A – Flower Blocks - Red (Colorway #3)

• Fussy cut (12) 10 ½" squares, centered on blocks.

Fabric B – Flowers - Red/Cream (Colorway #1)

Fabric B – Butterflies - Blue/Cream (Colorway #2)

Fabric B – Buds - Red (Colorway #3)

- Cut (2) 10 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (32) 10 ½" x 1 ½" strips.
- Cut (2) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (40) 3 ½" x 1 ½" strips.
- Cut (8) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (30) 1 ½" x 10 ½" strips.
- Cut (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (40) 1 ½" x 3 ½" strips.

FOR COLORWAY #3 ONLY

- Cut (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 2 ½" squares.
- Cut (7) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

- Cut (2) 10 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (16) 10 ½" x 3 ½" strips.
- Cut (4) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips (15) 3 ½" x 10 ½" strips.

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS - CONTINUED:

Fabric D - Main Floral - Cream (Colorway #1)

• Cut (2) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (20) 3 ½" squares

Fabric E – Buds - Red (Colorway #1)

Fabric E – Buds - Blue (Colorway #2)

Fabric E – Flowers - Red/Cream (Colorway #3)

• Cut (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (80) 1 ½" squares.

FOR COLORWAY #1 AND COLORWAY #2 ONLY

- Cut (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 2 ½" squares.
- Cut (7) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

Fabric F – Tulips - Red/Cream (Colorway #1)

Fabric F – Flowers - Blue/Cream (Colorway #2)

Fabric F – Tulips - Red Cream (Colorway #3)

- Cut (2) 6 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (11) 6 1/4" squares. Cut each square across both diagonals to make (44) 6 1/4" triangles.
- Cut (1) 3 ³/₈" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 3 ³/₈" squares. Cut each square across one diagonal to make (8) 3 ³/₈" triangles.

Fabric G - Main Floral - Red (Colorway #1)

- Cut (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 3" squares.
- Cut (2) 6 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 6 1/4" squares. Cut each square across both diagonals to make (48) 6 1/4" triangles.

Fabric H – Solid - Cream (Colorway #1)

- Cut (4) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- Cut (3) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 55 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

Backing - Your Choice

• Cut (2) 67" x WOF strips.

BLOCK ASSEMBLY:

Note: The arrows in diagrams represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations while assembling the various components.

- 1. Sew (1) 1 ½" Fabric E square to each end of (1) 1 ½" x 3 ½" Fabric B strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) 3 ½" x 1 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 3 ½" Fabric D square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) 5 ½" Block One square (Diagram 1). Repeat to make (20) Block One squares total.







- 2. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 10 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) 3 ½" x 10 ½" Fabric C strip lengthwise to make (1) 5 ½" x 10 ½" Block Two rectangle (Diagram 2). Repeat to make (15) Block Two rectangles total.
- 3. Sew (1) 10 ½" x 1 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 10 ½" x 3 ½" Fabric C strip lengthwise to make (1) 5 ½" x 10 ½" Block Three rectangle (Diagram 3). Repeat to make (16) Block Three rectangles total.





- 4. Sew together (4) Block One squares and (3) Block Two rectangles, end to end and alternating them from left to right, to make Row One (Diagram 4). Repeat to make Row Three, Row Five, Row Seven and Row Nine.
- 5. Sew together (4) Block Three rectangles and (3) 10 ½" Fabric A squares, alternating them from left to right, to make Row Two (Diagram 4). Repeat to make Row Four, Row Six and Row Eight.
- 6. Sew together the (9) pieced Rows, lengthwise and in numerical order from the top to bottom, to make the 50 ½" x 65 ½" Center Block (Diagram 4).



- 7. Sew together (2) 3 3/8" Fabric F triangles, (13) 6 1/4" Fabric G triangles and (12) 6 1/4" Fabric F triangles to make the Left Side Border (Diagram 5).
- 8. Sew together (2) 3 3/8" Fabric F triangles, (13) 6 1/4" Fabric G triangles and (12) 6 1/4" Fabric F triangles to make the Left Side Border (Diagram 6).



9. Sew together (2) 33/8" Fabric F triangles, (10) 6 1/4" Fabric G triangles and (9) 6 1/4" Fabric F triangles. Sew (1) 35/8" Fabric G square to each end of the newly sewn strip to make the Top Border (Diagram 7).

10. Sew together (2) 33/8" Fabric F triangles, (10) 6 1/4" Fabric G triangles and (9) 6 1/4" Fabric F triangles. Sew (1) 3 5/8" Fabric G square to each end of the newly sewn strip to make the Top Border (Diagram 8).


QUILT ASSEMBLY:

- 11. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the left and to the right sides of the Center Block.
- 12. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

- 13. For Colorway #1 and Colorway #2: Sew (1) 2 ½" x 70 ½" Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block.
- 14. Sew (1) 2 ½" Fabric E square to each end of (1) 2 ½" x 55 ½" Fabric H strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the newly sewn strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
- 15. For Colorway #3: Sew (1) 2 ½" x 70 ½" Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block.
- 16. Sew (1) 2 ½" Fabric B square to each end of (1) 2 ½" x 55 ½" Fabric H strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the guilt top.

FINISHING INSTRUCTIONS:

- 17. Sew the backing fabric together to make (1) 67" x 82" backing piece.
- 18. Sandwich your quilt top, batting and backing together and quilt as desired.
- 19. Once completely quilted, carefully trim your quilt, leaving a seam allowance for the binding.
- 20. Cut the binding strips (Fabric E for Colorway #1 and Colorway #2 and Fabric B for Colorway #3) and bind as desired.
