

THE VIRGINIA BEACH GARDEN CLUB FUND

The Virginia Beach Garden Club Fund is a long-term investment funded by donations from club members and friends. It was established to provide financial aid to the President and the Delegates when attending GCA and GCV meetings.

The fund was established in 1984 by a group of far-sighted garden club members specifically to offset the cost of attending GCA Annual Meetings, GCA Zone Meetings, GCV Annual Meetings, and GCV Board of Governors Meetings.

The interest from this fund provides financial aid to the President and the Delegates for hotel and travel expenses. Monies will be allocated to cover the cost of one hotel room. If other financial arrangements need to be made, it is at the discretion of the President. This financial information should accompany the invitation to the Delegates.

In the event that there are funds remaining, they shall be used to defray the cost of the Club GCA Horticulture Chairman attending The Shirley Meniece Conference and/or the Club Conservation Chairman attending The National Affairs and Legislative Meeting in Washington, DC. The money is only available to them once during their two year tenure.

Each January the percentage of the draw from The Virginia Beach Garden Club Fund will be established, with the advice of a financial advisor, by the Finance Committee with the approval of The Virginia Beach Garden Club Board.
