Breeding

Riwaka is a triploid aroma type bred during the development of New Zealand Hops with a Difference" programme. It was first released by New Zealand's Plant & Food Hop Research Centre in 1997. The ancestry of Riwaka is of Sazzer origin and the specially developed NZ-bred males.

Brewing

If you want to say New Zealand Hops in your beer than this variety says it all. The pure weight of the oil character experienced during selection carries right through to the glass. A punchy addition to the new world styles of Pale Ale an New Zealand Pilseners.
