## VINTAGE

The winter of 2019-2020 produced average rainfall throughout most of Northern California, with the bulk of precipitation January through May. Spring temperatures were mild and warm with bud break about two weeks earlier than average across the northern part of the state. Temperatures during the summer were above average with few nights of fog and cloud cover in the more coastal regions. The month of September was perfect for grape ripening and harvest was quickly wrapped up in the second week of October.

## VINEYARDS

At Eos, we believe great wines cannot be made without great fruit. We source our grapes from quality vineayrds in the premiere growing regions of CAlifornia, including Lake County, Sonoma County and all along the Central Coast. The geographical diversity of these regions yield a plethora of distinct microclimates and results in wiens with unique aromas, flavors and texture.

## 2020 CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Our 2020 California Cabernet Sauvignon offers aromas of black cherry, dark fig, and hints of tobacco. This wine is medium-bodied with striking notes of toasted oak and warm spices that complement the long finish of this luscious wine.
