This is an inky Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, rich feeling with bold cherry fruit, blackberry and a touch of bitter chocolate.

The Abruzzo wine region is located on the east coast of the Adriatic sea and is best known for its Montepulciano wine, which provides complex and rich aromas. It is one of the oldest wine-growing regions in the world.

A continental climate prevails in the mountainous interior and affects about two-thirds of the area, while the Mediterranean climate affects the coast. The influence of sea and mountains yields temperature fluctuations between day and night, which together with good drafts allows the cultivation of elegant wines.
