PLEASE READ AND UNDERSTAND ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE INSTALLATION.

- Application models vary, we recommend to verify fitment before beginning installation process.
- Images featured in the instruction documents may not always exactly match your model or part.

STEP 1

Park the vehicle on a smooth level surface.

STEP 2

Remove the 6 bolts on the upper fascia with a T15 torx bit.

See Figure 1.

STEP 3

Using a 7mm socket, remove the inner corner supports.

See Figure 2.

STEP 4

If the vehicle is equipped with factory fender flares, they will have to be removed. Use a T15 torx bit to remove the factory bolts and then pull loose the double sided tape that holds the flare to the fender. See Figure 3. Remove the 4 inner fender bolts with a T15 torx bit as you pull loose the factory fare.

STEP 5

If the vehicle doesn't have factory fender flares, remove the 7 inner fender bolts with a T15 torx bit.

STEP 6

Pull the inner fender back to gain access to remove the 3 bumper bolts with a 7mm socket.

STEP 7

Disconnect the plugs to the fog lights.

STEP 8

Remove the 2 front fascia bolts with a 10mm socket.

See Figure 7.

STEP 9

Using a 10mm socket remove the 2 lower fascia bolts from the frame.

See Figure 8.

STEP 10

Now carefully remove the front bumper and fascia.

STEP 11

Remove the 4 bolts holding the crash bar to the frame with a 15mm socket.

See Figure 9.

STEP 12

Remove the crash bar.

STEP 13

Using a reciprocating saw, remove the 8 vertical bars in the lower grille opening.

See Figures 11 & 12.

STEP 14

Place light bracket inside of air duct.

See Figures 13-15.

STEP 15

Align mounting holes with crash bar mounting holes.

See Figure 16.

STEP 16

Using factory hardware, install crash bar in factory location and tighten with a 15mm socket.

See Figure 17.

STEP 17

Reinstall the bumper and fascia, start 2 of the upper fascia screws to hold the bumper into place. Hold the air duct up over the internal foam while securing the bumper and fascia.

STEP 18

Pull the inner fender back and reinstall the 3 factory bumper bolts using a 7mm socket.

STEP 19

Reinstall the front 2 fascia factory bolts with a 10mm socket.

See Figure 20

STEP 20

Using factory hardware attach the fascia bracket to the frame support with a 10mm socket as shown in Figure 21.

Install the lower bumper supports with factory hardware and tighten with a 7mm socket.

Attach the inner fender with the factory fender screws and push pins. Tighten with a T15 torx bit.

STEP 23

If equipped with fender flares, remove the old tape and apply new double sided tape to the top edge of the fender flare. Install the factory bolts and tighten with a T15 torx bit.

STEP 24

Reconnect the wire harness for the factory fog lights.

STEP 25

Install all of the upper fascia screws and tighten with a T15 torx bit.

See Figure 25.

STEP 26

Using hardware supplied with Speed Demon 30" LED light, secure to mounts.

STEP 27

Tighten Allen bolt.
