## FOR YOUR ROSES

Like fish and chips, some plants just go together, helping prevent diseases, attracting beneficial insects, controlling pests and providing many other benefits. Here are some that will love your roses!



### GROUNDCOVERS

Alyssum, Echeveria, Violets, Lamb's Ears, Mondo Grass

Avoid plants that have dense and spreading root system that will compete for food or water.



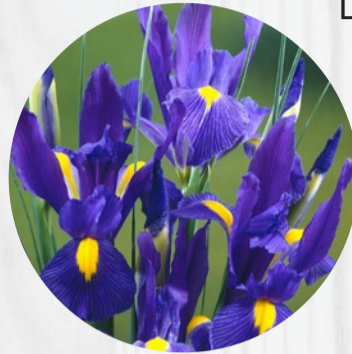
### INSECT REPELLENTS

Garlic, Lavender, Perennial Basil, Russian Sage, Scented Geraniums, Oregano, Thyme, Parsley, Tansy



### PERENNIALS

Delphinium, Lavender, Alstroemeria, Irises, Black Eyed Susan / Rudbeckia



### ANNUALS

Begonias, Impatiens, Marigolds, Pansies, Petunias, Primula, Viola, Poppies, Verbena



### ATTRACTING POLLINATORS

Beetroot, Carrots, Cabbage, Kale, Lettuce
