

PLANT A on ainer

FULL OF COLOURFUL BULBS

Spring bulbs already have a lot going for them, but one way to really amp up the interest is to plant bulbs lasagne-style. This is exactly as it sounds: layers of bulbs, planted one on top of the other, in order to extend the flowering period or make the most of the available space.

Mix and match bulbs in containers for a display that will delight!



A LARGE POT OR CONTAINER with drainage holes



POTTING MIX like Tui Pot Power



BULB FOOD like Tui Bulb Food



FLOWERING BULBS like crocus, anemone, earlycheer daffodils



MID SPRING FLOWERING BULBS like freesia, hyacinth, muscari, daffodil or ranunculus



LATE SPRING FLOWERING BULBS like daffodil, Dutch iris or tulip

HOW TO PLANT YOUR CONTAINER



STEP 1.

Prepare your containers.

Place a layer of gravel in the bottom of the pot (to help ensure good drainage) then add a 5cm layer of potting soil mixed with bulb food to your pot.



STEP 2

Plant the first layer of bulbs. Place the first layer of *late* spring flowering bulbs in the pot, tightly spaced at about 1cm spacing, and cover with about 5cm of soil.



STEP 3

Plant the second layer of bulbs.

Next, add *mid-spring bulbs*. Place them close together allowing space for the lower bulbs to grow through (about 2-3cm). Don't worry; the lower bulbs will find their way through the upper layers. Cover with about 5cm of soil.



STEP 4

Plant the top layer of bulbs. These are the small bulbs

that bloom in early spring. This time cover with 7cm of soil and a light dressing of bulb food.



STEP 5

The finishing touches. Add a layer of mulch and water.
