# DIY GARDENING PROJECTS \* FOR KIDS \*

## You will need

- Tray, 300 450 mm diameter
- Small stones or pebbles
- Pollinator plants, such as lavender, calendula, cosmos, foxgloves, zinnias or marigolds



Instructions

### Step 1 - finding the best position

Choose an area of your garden which contains pollinator attracting plants or plant your own.

#### Step 2 - getting the site ready

Clear an area of the garden bed, level the soil and place your tray on it.

#### Step 3 - filling the tray

Fill the tray with small stones and flat glass stones for decoration.

#### Step 4 - add water

Pour water over the stones but do not cover them completely. The bees will land on the stones in order to drink the water.

#### Step 5 - look after your watering station

This easy-to-make upcycled watering station provides water

for bees and other pollinators.

In addition to planting pollinator loving plants, this

is an excellent way to support

pollinators in your garden.

Regularly check the bee bath to prevent it from drying out. The bees will appreciate your support!
