## Butterfly Feeder

### You will need

- A 12 - 15 cm terracotta pot
- A 30cm terracotta saucer
- Colourful craft paints
- Paint brushes
- Strong glue
- An old sheet or tarpaulin



For maximum butterfly fun, place the feeder in the garden near the plants that attract butterflies, like salvia, wildflowers or alyssum.

### Instructions

#### Step 1 - attach pot to saucer

Apply glue to the bottom of the terracotta pot, then press the centre of the saucer down onto the glued area. Let the glue set completely before painting.

#### Step 2 - paint base coat

Once the pot and saucer are securely glued, paint them a bright base colour, like yellow, orange or red.

#### Step 3 - decorate it

Get creative with the paint job! You can use stencils to paint flowers, animals, shapes and anything that you like. These are the colours that butterflies love.



#### Step 4 - final setup

Place the butterfly feeder in your garden, near flowers, if you can. Add sugar water, fruit or both, to the saucer to attract butterflies.

These are some of the fruits that butterflies love.
