Thumbprint Flower Pot

You will need

- Terracotta pot
- Paper plate
- Acrylic paints
- Permanent marker
- Paint brush
- Potting mix
- Plants



So simple and so much fun to make, this one-of-a-kind flower pot will be sure to brighten anyone's day. Pop into your local Palmer's to find pots, plants and potting mix to complete this project.



Instructions

Step 1.

First paint the top lip of the flower pot with polka dots or a coloured stripe.

Step 2.

Squeeze some paint onto a paper plate and use your thumb to make a butterfly shape on the flower pot. Larger pots will allow room for more than one butterfly.

Step 3.

Once the paint has dried, use a permanent marker to draw a body and antennae for the butterfly.

Step 4.

Visit your local Palmer's to purchase annuals or herbs to plant in your newly decorated pot.
