Step 1.

First paint the top lip of the flower pot with polka dots or a coloured stripe.

Step 2.

Squeeze some paint onto a paper plate and use your thumb to make a butterfly shape on the flower pot. Larger pots will allow room for more than one butterfly.

Step 3.

Once the paint has dried, use a permanent marker to draw a body and antennae for the butterfly.

Step 4.

Visit your local Palmers to purchase annuals or herbs to plant in your newly decorated pot.
