WHERE TO USE

Use on all roses, including but not limited to antique roses, climbing roses, floribundas, grandiflora roses, knockout roses, miniature roses, rosa banksias and tea roses.

WHEN TO USE: FEBRUARY–NOVEMBER

Apply NutriStar Rose food monthly during the growing season.

HOW TO USE

Plant in the ground: Distribute NutriStar Rose food evenly over planted area and water thoroughly. Use at a rate of ½ cup per 10 sq. ft. and 5 cups per 100 sq. ft.

TRANSPLANTING

Thoroughly mix 1 cup per cubic foot of NutriStar Rose food into the soil. Place the plant(s) and water thoroughly after each application.
