#### WHERE TO USE

**Use on all roses, including but not limited to** antique roses, climbing roses, floribundas, grandiflora roses, knockout roses, miniature roses, rosa banksias and tea roses.

## WHEN TO USE: FEBRUARY-NOVEMBER

Apply NutriStar Rose food monthly during the growing season.
