Why Nordman Firs? Simple The Nordman Fir has excellent needle retention. Even after the tree dries out, Nordman Firs will hold on to most of their needles standing up to the central heating in your home much better than the traditional Norway Spruce which brings dread to many after childhood memories of standing on thousands of pin like needles.

Step 1

Leave your tree outside or better still, in your garage to keep it dry until you are ready to bring it inside for decoration.

Step 2

Leave your tree in its net and cut around 1-2 inches off its base to allow the fresh cut to drink up water. Your tree can drink over 1 ltr of water every day when in your home.

Step 3

Choose a spot in your home away from any heat source such as a radiator and avoid placing your tree in the same room as a fire.

Step 4

Take your tree inside still in its net. It is easier to handle this way and easier to fit in its stand without crawling under the branches.

Tip: make sure your stand holds water.

Step 5

Take the net off your tree and allow its branches to settle for an hour or so before decorating.

Tip: remember to check your lights are working before putting on the tree. We sell a great range of lights to make your tree sparkle.

Step 6

Get the kids involved in decorating the tree.

Tip: you can always change it when they go to bed....

Step 7

Keep your tree topped up with water each day, remember the hotter the room the more water it will drink.

Step 8

Christmas has passed and it's time to take down the tree. Remove all decorations and store carefully. A piece of cardboard can be used to wrap strings of lights around to keep them tangle free. Finally use an old double duvet cover to wrap your tree and remove it to keep your home needle free.
