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### **IRON CURTAIN CAME DOWN AND EMMAUS MOVED IN**

### PART 2

In the previous issue of *The ECS Connection* we described the thriving Emmaus Correspondence School ministries taking place in ex-Soviet countries. In October 2004, over 160 course instructors from the Ukraine, Moldova, Belarus, and the Russian Federation assembled in the town of Belgorod-Dnevstrosky, Ukraine for 3 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> days of hearing reports, teaching on how to be more effective as instructors, Bible teaching, and fellowship.

Participants like Jakov of Belarus help in the distribution of 12,000 Emmaus courses a year to these spiritually hungry people. In the Ukraine, some 300 instructors help distribute 60,000 courses each year! And in Moldova, 30,000 courses have been distributed in the past three years with a completion rate of around 50%.

But what initiatives began these ministries? How is the correspondence work conducted in these countries?

After the break up of the Soviet Union in 1989, Martin Vedder of the German assemblies had the

vision of getting Emmaus courses into Russia and the ex-Soviet states. Responding to Martin's challenge, Andreas and Monika Reh were commended from Germany in 1993 to begin the work. In Kiev, the capital of the Ukraine, the work grew quickly. In 1995 Andreas moved his family to Russia to continue developing the work that was simultaneously growing there and in other former Soviet countries.

Presently in Russia there are 20 regions where Emmaus is represented, from St. Petersburg in the extreme northwest to Sakhalin Island just north of Japan. Four coordinators and about 300 instructors distribute and correct courses locally in their regions. This enables over 6,000 active students to study more than 45,000 courses a year. Praise the Lord!

In all of these CIS countries (Commonwealth of Independent States) their system of distributing Emmaus courses is straightforward and effective. They use 24 courses in Russian, studied in a specific

sequence. Students learn of the courses through word of mouth, their churches, or invitation cards distributed door-to-door. After a student completes the first 12 courses and shows spiritual insight and growth, he or she is then invited to become an instructor. He or she keeps a small stock of these first 12 courses in their home and is responsible for recruiting new students, distributing the courses, collecting, and grading them. Once the instructor has finished all 24 courses, he or she can stock and grade them all.

However, if a student asks a question the instructor cannot answer, the instructors are taught to go to their local elders or pastor for help. This involves the local church in the program and encourages the church to use the courses. The advantages to this straightforward program are:

- 1) Distributes responsibility and workload
- 2) Promotes rapid ministry growth
- Makes the national instructors "owners" of the work
- 4) Avoids the use of costly or often inefficient postal services
- 5) Spreads Emmaus offices and accessibility across the country
- 6) Encourages local church participation
- 7) Involves many people in the ministry

Meet Sveta, a young mother from Belarus, who testified how she asked God for a way to serve Him



while caring for her young children. After completing her twelfth course, she was thrilled when presented with the opportunity of grading Emmaus courses. She has been

instrumental in getting neighborhood children to study the courses, thereby also involving their mothers.

A believer from Minsk, Belarus, described how through the Emmaus courses he has helped 37 older

people in his church. Another instructor has 89 students in an area where there was previously no church, but where now a church of 10 meets—a victory for restrictive Belarus!

Ana, an older woman, remembers the Soviet days. With gold tooth flashing, she tells how she has developed 2 instructors in each of the nearby villages so that she now "only" handles 230 students personally!

Oh, for a zeal like theirs to reach the unsaved and build up the body of believers! It is through these Emmaus Correspondence School courses and the contribution and efforts of believers that God's Word is reaching people, bringing them to the Savior, and transforming their lives.

Why has ECS Ministries begun ECO? A growing number of people are using their computers for educational / learning purposes. In many areas of the world mail service is inefficient and costly, but Internet cafés are becoming increasingly popular. Plus although some national boundaries restrict religious literature, the Internet gets through.

Currently, *Men Who Met the Master* is published online in both English and German. Under development are courses in Arabic, Spanish and Polish, with a short term goal of having one to three of the basic courses in the most-used languages.




# FROM AROUND THE WORLD

### A NEW WAY INSIDE?


