Pink 3'- 4' tall June-August

Purple 3'- 6' tall Sept-Oct



MARSH **BLAZING STAR** Liatris spicata

Pink 3'- 4' tall July-August



WILD COLUMBINE

Aquilegia canadensis Red 1'- 3' tall May-July



BEARDTONGUE

Penstemon digitalis White 3'- 4' tall June-July



PURPLE CONEFLOWER Echinacea Purpurea

Pink 3'- 4' tall June-August



BLACK-EYED SUSANS

Rudbeckia hirta Yellow 1'- 3' tall June-Sept
