Swivel Wheel Kit Parts List:

- Swivel arm forks (2)
- Swivel wheel axle connector U-bracket (1)
- Wheel with mounting pin
- Hex head bolts with nuts (3)
- Hand knob screws (2)
- Hex key tool and spanner wrench



Install the Wheel

Take the swivel wheel fork and insert the axle into the hole in the swivel wheel axle connector U-bracket



Assemble the fork

Take the forks and slide over the swivel wheel U-bracket as shown. Do not insert the bolt and nut at this time.





Secure the Wheel

Insert the bolt through the hole in the U-bracket and fix in place with the nut and bolt. Fasten with the hex key and spanner.



Align the fork tubes

Once installed the fork legs will swivel on the U-bracket. Take the assembly and position near the front lower trailer frame and insert the fork



Securing the fork

Press the fork U-bracket up to alian with the trailer frame. Align the fork ends with the corresponding hole on the trailer frame and secure with the QR pins.





Securing the fork

Insert the hand knob screws through the slot on the underside of the assembly and thread into the corresponding hole in the trailer frame. Repeat on the opposite side.



Securing the assembly

During the fork assembly, the holes in the U-bracket and the fork legs should now be aligned. Now that the forks are installed on the frame as shown, insert the remaining two bolts and nuts to secure the U-bracket to the fork assembly.

Tighten the bolts securely with the hex key and spanner wrench provided. Recheck all fasteners are secure!
