

Accell to Ship USB-C Adapter With Charging Port

Accell's USB-C to USB-A 3.0 Adapter with USB-C Rapid Charging Port converts a device's USB-C port into a USB-A port, and is equipped with a USB-C charging receptacle. This adapter is plug-and-play ready, requiring no additional software or driver. It easily enables use of a flash drive, charge/sync cable, mouse, or other USB-A accessory and simultaneous charging of the host device, from the same USB-C port.

Accell's USB-C to USB-A 3.0 Adapter is USB 3.0 compliant with data transfer speeds up to 4.8Gbps. Its USB-A output is 5V at 900mA, and its USB-C max charging power is 20V at 3A. It requires no external power, and its power consumption is 5V at 120mA. The adapter measures approximately 6.9 inches long.

Accell's new adapter is compatible with the following system requirements: USB Type-C port, Windows XP and above, Mac OS 10.6 and above, and Chrome OS. This adapter also includes a two-year replacement warranty.
