## Display adapters

Want to connect your shiny new USB-C tablet, phone or notebook to your current display? You can with a USB-C video converter.

Take, for example, Belkin's USB-C to VGA Adapter, which plugs into a USB-C port on your system and can handle up to 1920 x 1080 resolution; Belkin is working on a 4K HDMI version.

Google's USB Type-C to HDMI Adapter and Accell's USB-C to HDMI 1.4 Adapter can each deliver up to 4K resolution output right now.
