



PRODUCT NAME: Mushroom Soil

Mushroom soil is the substrata used in commercial mushroom growing. It is sold after the mushroom crop is harvested. Mushroom soil can contain a variety of materials and varies from lot to lot. It is usually steamed, pasteurized and partially composted. Use with restraint – 25% Mushroom Soil to 75% Soil or Potting Medium.

COVERAGE: (Approx. for 1 Cubic Yard) 240 sqft @ 1" depth 120 sqft @ 2" depth 80 sqft @ 3" depth 40 sqft @ 4" depth

BLEND: May contain hardwood dust, coconut coir, vermiculite, peat moss, rice, cottonseed hulls, soybean and canola meal. Also, wheat straw, gypsum, and manure, usually horse or chicken.
