


Feature Introduction



How to Install the Batteries?




- 1. Battery Requirement: 2pcs * AA batteries

- 3. Insert two batteries according to the positive and negative electrode

Operation and Usage



- ① Attach the cold shoe adapter to the receiver, and mount it on the camera/photographic equipment.
- ② Plug one end of the 3.5mm audio cable into the receiver's "LINE OUT" socket and the other end into the camera's "MIC" interface.
- ③ Push the power button to turn on the device.

Transmitter

- ① Insert the lavalier mic into MIC socket of the transmitter.
- 2 Push the power button to turn on the device.
- 3 Clip the receiver on your belt or put it in the pocket.
- ☆ Long press "Channel" button, to change channel number.
- ☆ Press "Volume" button to adjust the sound volume.
