


Ressa Wallhung US-RS200W INSTALLATION MANNUAL

- 9. During installation, disassembly, repaire and maintenance of the product, the power supply must be switched off and water supply be shut off.

- 1. Closed supervision is necessary when this product is used by, on, or near children or invalids.
- 2. Use this product only for its intended use as described in this manual. Do not use attachments not recommended by the manufacturer.
- 3. Never operate this product if it has a damaged cord or connector, if it is not working properly, if it has been dropped or damaged, or dropped into water. Return the product to a service center for examination and repair.
- 4. If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent or similarly qualified persons in order to avoid a hazard.
- 5. Keep the cord away from heated surfaces.
- 6. Never use while sleeping or drowsy.
- 7. Never drop or insert any object into any opening or hose.
- 8. Do not use outdoors or operate where aerosol (spray) products are being used or where oxygen is being administered.
- 9. Connect this product to a properly grounded outlet only. See Grounding Instructions.
- 10. Do not throw cigarettes and other burning stuff into toilet, otherwise it might cause fire.
- 11. This product is electric appliance, so it must be placed far away from water. Please don't drench urine and other liquid to it.
- 12. Do not lay on side or upside the product during the electrical circuit.
- 13. It is prohibited to use other electric appliances in the same socket.
- 14. It is forbidden to use the power extension or unstable loose outlet.
- 15. The old aging water supply hose can not be used, otherwise it might cause leakage, fire or electrical shock. Installation of the bidet seat should include specified components and new water supply hose.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS



CAUTION-Indicates that failure to follow the instruction may cause body injury or property damage.

- 1. Do not install or use the product in wet places as steam room etc.
- 2. It is recommended to use water-proof electrical outlet which should be installed in the place where is not easily got wet.
- 3. This product should be used with 110V-120V, 50/60Hz electrical current only,load current is at least 15A. Power supply must be equipped with ground fault circuit interrupter or ground fault electrical leakage protector or similar high sensitive, rapid type leakage switch (Rated sensitive current under 6mA).
- 4. To install a product that is not equipped with a plug, a switch device that can completely disconnect the power supply of the product must be installed at the front end of the fixed wiring.
- 5. When it thunders, cut off the power supply immediately.
- 6. Do not stand on ceramic toilet.
- 7. Do not stand on product unit, seat and cover.
- 8. Do not lean against the seat cover when using the product, to avoid damage.
- 9. This product is equipped with soft-closing seal cover. Heavy pressing or pushing may damage the soft-closing damper.
- 10. Do not use lacquer thinner, petrol, liquid medicine, detergent, insecticide, toilet cleanser and scrubbing brush to clean the product.
- 11. Exposure to direct sunlight is prohibited.
- 12. Only use tap water or potable water; otherwise it may cause chafing.
- 13. Do not connect water supply to heater outlet. Make sure inlet water temperature at 3~35°C.
- 14. When the room temperature is under zero degree, please dry up the water tank, to avoid freezing.
- 15. Raise rest room temperature to prevent the toilet from damage due to freezing.
- 16. When move the product from cold or wet environment into normal room temperature, wait for 2 hours until the condensation water is fully volatilized. Doing so can prevent the product from electrical short-circuit.
- 17. When not using the product over three(3) days, drain the water out of the container and cut off the power supply.
- 18. Stop using the product and shut off the power when product malfunctions, please contact the service people for professional service.

GROUNDING INSTRUCTIONS

This product should be grounded. In the event of an electrical short circuit, grounding reduces the risk of electric shock by providing an escape wire for the electric current. This product is equipped with a cord having a grounding wire with a grounding connector. The connector must be connected to the ground wire correctly.



DANGER – Improper use of the grounding can result in a risk of electric shock.

If repair or replacement of the cord or connector is necessary, do not connect the grounding wire to either flat blade terminal. The wire with insulation having an outer surface that is green with or without yellow stripes is the grounding wire.

Under the condition of ambient temperature 23°C/73°F, water static pressure 0.18MPa±0.02MPa, water temperature 15°C/59°F, power toilet on, set water pressure, seat temperature, water temperature to the highest level in turn and perform one rear washing cycle.



Circuit pre-installation: Install a fixed electrical supply circuit (Neutral wire, live wire and ground wire included.)

- ·Confirm the electrical connection location.
- ·Reserve pipeline for electrical circuit

Circuit breaker pre-installation

- ·Connect a separate upstream circuit breaker.
- ·Pre-connect an earth leakage circuit breaker or grounding protector for other independent circuits.

Waterway pre-installation

·Reserve pipeline for water supply hose.






Before installation

1. Minimum static water pressure: 0.08+MPa (8.5L+L/min), failure to meet this pressure will not achieve the best flushing effect.

Note: Apply the methods below if you don't have water pressure testing device. Open the angle valve to check the water volume. If the water volume after 10 seconds is greater than 1.42L, then it is OK to proceed installation.




2. Pass the cord through the wall and then strip the cord to ensure the ground wire is 5mm longer than neutral wire and live wire.




3. Installation of power switch




1. Unpack and confirm the list of materials.




2. Open the seat, then remove screws and washers.




3. Close the seat, and remove it from the toilet. Gently put it on a clean cardboard to avoid any damage.







4. Measure the flush pipe.




5. Cut off the excess pipe.








8. Bevel and deburr the sharp edges.










11. Remove the protective sleeve on bolts. Apply silicone oil on the in-wall flush pipe and drain pipe orifice.








15. Fit the water supply hose, off-seat auto flushing cable and power cord through the toilet.






19. Apply silicone around the toilet.



- 20. Connect the seat to toilet and power supply.
 - 1) Connect seat to toilet water supply hose with the on/off valve.
 - 2) Connect the off-seat auto flushing cable to the connection end on seat.
 - 3) Attach two piece of velcro as shown below to secure cables in position.
 - 4) Connect the power cord to the connection cable on seat.




21. Position the seat and check the alignment.




22. Wrap velcro on water supply hose and power cord coupler respectively, and then stick them to pre-installed velcro on both sides of the toilet, as shown below.

Open the seat, fix screws and decorative caps and then lock tight.





23. Close the seat. Finish the installation of toilet.



24. Remote control installation


Step 1: Fix the holder onto the wall by using screws or tape, as shown in below diagrams.






Step 2: Insert 3 x AAA batteries (not supplied) into the remote control.

Step 3: Put remote control into the holder.





Notice: Do not install and use the product in damp places such as a shower room.

Do not place the product in a place where it is easily exposed to water.


Maintenance

Main unit care and maintenance

1. Shut off the power supply before doing maintenance.



2. Wipe with a soft damp cloth. Use warm water only.




3. After cleaning, turn on power.



Spray nozzle maintenance

- 1. Nozzle self-cleaning.
 - To start the manual cleaning function, when not seated, press "REAR" button on the side panel of toilet, the spray nozzle will automatically extend out and self-cleaning.
- 2. Spray nozzle disassemble
 - When the nozzle moves forward, the nozzle head can be removed to clean by pulling it towards.



- 3. Use only a soft cloth to clean.
 - Do not pull or push the wand, to avoid damage.
- 4. Nozzle retraction
- Put the nozzle head back on and press the "Stop" button on the remote control to automatically retract the nozzle.


Note: The spray wand will retract automatically after 10 minutes or if the seat is used.

Emergency troubleshooting

Filter Cleaning

If poor spray performance occurs under normal conditions:

1. Turn off power and on/off valve, unscrew water supply hose.




- 2. Remove the filter.
- 3. Rinse the filter under running water.
- 4. Reinstall filter and water supply hose, turn on/off valve and connect power.

Power and water failure

• Fill around 8L water into a barrel and flush the ceramic bowl.

Note: Avoid water splashing from bowl.



Failure of remote control

1. Operate via buttons on the main unit.



- 2. Battery replacement
 - Take off the remote control from holder.
 - Open the battery cover and replace the batteries.
 - Put the remote control back.


Note: After battery replacement, the settings of auto functions and energy saving will be restored to the defaults. Please reset if needed.

Description of the side control panel function

Description of the button function		
ECO	 Press "Stop" Button for longer than 3 seconds to enter shutdown mode (red light off). Press "Stop" Button again to return to functional mode (red light on). In shutdown mode, all functions and buttons (with the exception of the Stop Button) will not operate. When seated, short press "Stop" Button to stop front washing, rear washing or drying functions; When not seated, repeatedly press "Stop" Button, the main unit will switch between functional mode (red light) and energy saving mode (blue light). 	
	When seated, press "Dry" Button to start drying function. The drying will stop automatically after one cycle, and it will stop immediately if the user presses "Stop" Button.	
	When seated, press "FRONT/MOVE" Button to start front washing function and press again to shift to oscillating washing. Press "Stop" Button to stop front washing immediately.	
	 When seated, press "REAR/MOVE" Button to start rear washing function and press again to shift to oscillating washing. Press "Stop" Button to stop rear washing immediately. When not seated, press "REAR/MOVE" Button, the nozzle will stretch out to allow access for cleaning; Press "Stop" Button, the nozzle will retract. 	

- Note: 1. In energy saving mode, power indicator red is off, and energy saving indicator blue is on; In functional mode, power indicator is on, and energy saving indicator is off; In shutdown mode, all indicators are off.
 - 2. Default settings for all functions are intermediate when powering on. Use remote control to switch to the function level set before.

Remote control illustration



Energy Saving

Press the "STOP" button for longer than 3 seconds to enter energy saving mode, the power indicator is off and energy saving light is on. Press "STOP" button again for longer than 3 seconds to exit energy saving mode, the power indicator is on and energy saving light is off.

Under energy saving mode, seat temperature is set to Level 1 for energy saving. (Note: If the seat temperature before energy saving is neutral, then it will be neutral as well.)

Remark:


Energy saving mode will be suspended and the product will enter functional mode if the seat is used. The seat starts to heat immediately (without turning off the seat temperature), and the energy saving mode is restored once the seat is no longer being used.

Rear/Front washing

- · Press "REAR" button, the indicator light is on showing current water temperature level, it starts rear washing; Press again "REAR" button to shift to oscillating washing (nozzle moves forward and backward to expand washing area). The washing will stop automatically after one cycle, while it will stop immediately if the user presses "STOP" button.
- · Press "FRONT" button, the indicator light is on showing current water temperature level, it starts front washing; Press again "FRONT" button to shift to oscillating washing (nozzle moves forward and backward to expand washing area). The washing will stop automatically after one cycle, while it will stop immediately if the user presses "STOP" button.


Drying operation

· Press "DRY" button, the indicator light is on, showing current air temperature level, it starts drying; The drying will stop automatically after one cycle or after the user leaves the seat.



Temperature adjustment

- · Water temperature adjustment Short press "WATER TEMP" button to adjust the water temperature between 0-5 level. The indicator light is on showing current water temperature level. When the indicator is off, the temperature is at level 0.
- Dryer temperature adjustment
 Short press "DRYER TEMP" button to adjust the dryer temperature between 0-5 level. The indicator light is on showing current dryer temperature level. When the indicator is off, the temperature is at level 0.
- Seat temperature adjustment Short press "SEAT TEMP" button to adjust the seat temperature between 0-5 level. The indicator light is on showing current seat temperature level. When the indicator is off, the temperature is at level 0.




Water volume adjustment

 Press " + " or " - " button when it is under function of rear washing or front washing, the indicator light is on showing current water volume level, and water volume can be adjusted in 3 levels.

Nozzle position adjustment

 Press " \(\) " or " \(\) " button when it is under function of rear washing or front washing, the indicator light is on showing current nozzle position, and nozzle position can be adjusted in 5 levels.




Auto mode

The system can store 2 individual settings.



Once the desired configuration is set, for instance, water volume and nozzle position, one can press the Auto mode 1 or mode 2 button to store the settings. (Mode 1 is for rear cleaning and Mode 2 is for front cleaning.)

When pressing the Auto Mode button, the system will automatically switch to the settings stored previously, and follow the below procedures for a complete cleaning process. Press any button in between to abort the process.



Night light

Quickly press the "LIGHT" button to turn on/turn off night light, press and hold the "LIGHT" button to enter into intelligent mode (The night light will be on or off depending on the surrounding light). If the product is on intelligent mode, quickly press the "LIGHT" button to exit intelligent mode.



Half flush/Full flush

- · Short press "FULL FLUSH" button, the toilet starts full flushing.
- · Short press "HALF FLUSH" button, the toilet starts half flushing.
- Long press "FULL FLUSH" button to turn on/off auto flushing function.
 When the auto flushing function is turned on, toilet will automatically flush after detecting user sitting for more than 6 seconds and leaving the seat for more than 3.5 seconds.



Water tank flush volume adjustment

- · Press and hold "FULL FLUSH" button, and press water volume " + " button to increase full flush volume by 1 level;
- · Press and hold "FULL FLUSH" button, and press water volume " " button to reduce full flush volume by 1 level;
- · Press and hold "HALF FLUSH" button, and press water volume " + " button to increase half flush volume by 1 level;
- · Press and hold "HALF FLUSH" button, and press water volume " " button to reduce half flush volume by 1 level.

Note: When flush volume is adjusted to the minimum or maximum, the buzzer beeps twice.

User Code

RF remote control

- · Once power is connected and self-inspection completes, press and hold "STOP" button, then press "REAR" button, the indicator light will flash. And the code matching information is automatically generated. Press the combination button again to exit the user code matching mode, and the buzzer beeps after code matching completes.
- The RF remote control has been calibrated before delivery. If the remote control does not work at the beginning, or a new remote control is used, the code needs to be re-calibrated.
- The code matching will complete within 30 seconds. If the code matching fails, power off the main unit and perform the code matching again.

Other operations

Quite mode

· Press and hold the "SEAT TEMP" button to turn on/off quite mode.

Auto deodorization

· Long press "HALF FLUSH" button to turn on/off auto deodorization function. The deodorization function will be automatically turned on when user is seated, and will stop after user leaves the seat for 3 seconds. Under drying, deodorization will stop.

Remark:

- The buzzer will "BEEP" once when the user presses one button indicating that the main unit receives the signal and conduct the operation accordingly. If the buzzer doesn't sound, it means the main unit doesn't receive the signal, please adjust the remote control direction and repress the button.
- In case of power cut during nozzle spraying, the wand cannot retract, please wait until the power is restored. In case of a power cut for a long period, please push the wand softly back by hand. Do not push hard, to avoid damage to wand and electrical machine.
- Only when user is seated and the buzzer beeps, the functions of front/rear washing and drying can be activated. The nozzle will continue to spray for 1-2 seconds after user stands up during washing, so please press "STOP" button before standing up.

Troubleshooting Guide

Poor flushing	The cistern tank is not fully refilled.	Flush till the cistern tank is fully refilled
Not flushing	On/off valve in the cistern tank is shut off.	Turn on the on/off valve, wait until the tank is fully refilled.
	A power outage occurred.	Push the flushing plate to mannually flush.
	A water failure occurred.	Use a bucket to mannually flush.
	Previous flushing cycle is not finished.	Wait until the previous cycle finishes then flush.
Auto flushing does not work	"Auto flushing" is set to "OFF".	Set to "ON". Refer to page 27.
	The seat switch will not turn on unless the user is seated properly.	Sit back on the toilet seat.
Low water temperature	The water temperature is not set properly.	Adjust the water temperature.
	When the temperature of the water supply or of the bathroom is low, the water temperature may be low when first sprayed.	
	The seat temperature is not set properly.	Reset the seat temperature.
Low seat temperature	In energy saving mode.	Switch to functional mode and wait for 5+ minutes. Refer to page 24.
	In standby mode.	Switch to functional mode and wait for 3+ minutes. Refer to page 24.
	When seated, after 10 minutes, the temperature begins to decrease. Then after 5 minutes, the toilet seat heater turns to level 1 and stays.	Stand up from the seat and then sit again.
Low air temperature	The air temperature is not set properly	Reset the air temperature.

Problem	Cause	Solution
Waste material does not flush down completely	Flushing may be difficult depending the consistency of the waste material.	Flush the toilet again. If the bowl unit is not cleansed with a flushing, remove the stains with a brush or similar instrument.
	The cistern tank is not fully refilled.	Flush till the cistern tank is fully refilled
Water is leaking from the plumbing connections	Inspect to see if any nuts in the connection are loose or washers pre-fitted in the hoses are missing.	Firmly tighten the nuts with washers.
	Water leak does not stop.	Close the on/off valve and consult service provider.
There are black stains on or around the bowl unit	Ammonia in urine may cause black stains.	If urine has splashed on the bowl unit or floor, wipe it up immediately.
There is black or pink slime on the toilet bowl surface	This is a result of growth of airborne fungal spores or bacteria that feed on waste residue on the toilet bowl.	Clean with (non-abrasive) neutral toilet detergent.
There is residue on the bowl unit surface	Oil and other hard-to-see grime may stick to the bowl unit surface.	Clean with (non-abrasive) neutral toilet detergent.
Night light does not work	Night light function is "OFF".	Set to "ON".
Remote control	The positive and negative direction of batteries is incorrect.	Re-load batteries.
does not work	Batteries have expired.	Load new batteries.
	The drying feature stops automatically after about 5 minutes of continuous use.	
Stop in the middle of use	The cleaning feature stops automatically after about 2.5 minutes of continuous use.	
	The seat switch have difficulty detecting that the seat is in use. Sit back on the toilet seat. If the user gets up slightly from the seat, or sits forward on the seat, the seating switch may temporarily stop detecting user's presence.

Emergency trouble shooting

1. Water supply failure:

Fill about 6L water in a bucket and flush the toilet.

2. Power supply failure:

The toilet can be flushed by manual pushing the flush plate at the front of in wall tank. (This function is only for the toilet is fitted on Ressa in wall carrier)

3. Remote control does not work.

Operate the toilet on the side control panel of toilet.

Replace new batteries for remote control.

A mild detergent, warm water and a soft cloth will remove normal dirt and soap accumulations from surfaces. Soft abrasive cleaners may be used on vitreous china. Never use abrasive cleaners without water. Do not use caustic cleaners or disinfectants as they can alter the surface finish and void the warranty.


Use toilet bowl cleaners on the inside of the bowl only. Remove any splashes of cleaner solution from plastic or plated surfaces immediately.

Do not allow certain materials such as toothpaste, cologne, shaving cream, nail polish remover, vinegar, wine, drain and glass cleaners to remain on the surface. Prolonged contact can alter surface finishes and void the warranty.

CARE OF TOILET SEATS

Use a soft, damp cloth and a mild soap such as dishwashing liquid to clean the seat. Rinse the seat and dry with a soft towel. Do not use abrasive cleaners as they will scratch and dull the surface. Do not allow cosmetics or abrasive chemicals to come in contact with the toilet seat.










To install tank and carrier, a 2 x 4" or 2 x 6" wooded or metal frame construction is required.

Studs must be placed 23 1/4" apart (clearance) where carrier will be positioned inside the wall.

For 3 1/2" wall thickness vertical drainage only.

For 5 1/8" min. wall thickness RH, LH and vertical drainage possible.




FFL: Finished Floor Level

FSH: Finished Seat Height (min 18 7/8" (479mm)) WFH: Wall Fixing Height (min 49 1/4"(1252mm)) Determine FFL by adjusting the feet of steel frame by

changing the pin setting in the carrier foot.






Position carrier in frame to level. Adjust feet height as needed.


Carrier face plate must be flushed with front of the surrounding studs to accomplish maximum support for the wall sheeting(applied later).

A. For wooden wall frame installation.




With the carrier in place, mark all anchor and bolt hole locations onto studs of wooden frame.



Remove carrier from wooden frame and drill holes.




Set carrier back in place and install anchor bolts on the base. With anchor bolts set, ensure carrier is flush to stud frame. Adjust as needed before installing side stud bolts.




With carrier set in place, secure carrier to studs by installing 4 stud bolts in marked locations.

Ensure it is secure and even.


B. For metal wall frame installation.(Fittings are not supplied)




Drill out 2 marked 2/5"(10mm)anchor holes in the carrier base. Secure carrier feet in place within the frame using metal frame bolts. With anchor bolts set, ensure carrier is flush to metal frame front. Adjust as needed before installing side metal screws.



Install 6 self-tapping screws 12" apart into the metal to secure carrier within frame.




Install 2" or 3" wide 12ga studs that are connected to the floor and ceiling with mounting brackets for optimal support. Install additional 12"(30cm) lateral plywood or drywall reinforcement for studs thinner than 12ga.



Ensure it is secure and even.







Position A: for 90° drop. use the front support holders.

Position B: for 45° drop. use the rear support holders. Install waste outlet no more than 45° right or left with a minimum vertical drop of one pipe diameter before transitioning to horizontal pitch.













Remove actuator cover and ensure that the inlet on/off valve is completely turned off before connecting water supply. Purage the water into an empty bucket to ensure any debris is cleared out of water supply line. Apply teflon around threads and connect the water pipe.
