



INFLATABLE PADDLE BOARD

SETUP


- 1. LEASH ANCHOR POINT
- 2. LUGGAGE STRAPS
- 3. HANDLE
- 4. EVA DECKPAD
- **5. MAIN VALVE**
- 6. FIN

- 7. 3 PIECE PADDLE
- 8. BAG & PUMP



ASSEMBLY

- 1. When rolling out the paddle board ensure that there are no sharp or hot objects on the ground.
- 2. Ensure that the non-return valve is closed. For this purpose, the black pin, in the upper position, should be at the height of the grey ring. If this is not the case, turn the black pin 90 degrees counter-clockwise.



- 4. Connect the hose, from the supplied pump including sealing ring (black), to the valve and let it snap into place by turning the pump connection clockwise.
- 5. Pump up your paddle board with the included hand pump to 12-15 psi. The psi will only start to register on the pump when vou hit 7 psi.



7. For the 9'6" slide the fin into the mounting rail and secure it

The 11' has a US Box Fin.

with the pin.


- Unscrew the plate from the screw (Figure 1) and place into the fin slot via the gap (Figure 2). TIP: Use the screw to slide the plate into place along the slot.
- Insert the fin into the fin box slot via the central gap, slide the fin to the back and firmly push down the other end (Figure 3).
- Line up the screw with the screw plate and tighten until fully secure (Figure 4).























ON THE WATER

- The standard standing position is with your feet in the direction you are traveling and at the height of the transport handle.
- 2. Hold the paddle as shown.
- Holding your balance is like riding a bicycle: The more speed you have, the more stable the board becomes.

DISASSEMBLY

- 1. Demount the fins.
- Clean your paddle board with fresh water (where possible).
- 3. Open the valve cover and turn the pin 90 degrees clockwise, so that it is in the lowered position and the air can flow out.
- Roll your paddle board from the side opposite the valve with the deck on the inside of you and, conversely, the fins on the outside.



SUP PROTECTION AND STORAGE

The ideal storage location is a dry cool place. If space is limited, store the paddle board loosely rolled with the valve open. In addition the paddle board should be stored away from dirt and sharp objects. Please avoid the following situation:

- · Contact with sharp, hot or dirty objects.
- Your paddle board in the sun for an unnecessarily long time.
