BEANIE

PATTERN

BEANIE

Red yarn.

Rnd 1. Start 6 sc in a magic loop (6)

To keep track of where you are, use a stitch marker to mark the beginning of each round. Each time you start a new round, move the stitch marker to the first stitch of that round.

Rnd 2. inc x 6 (12)

Rnd 3. [sc, inc] x 6 (18)

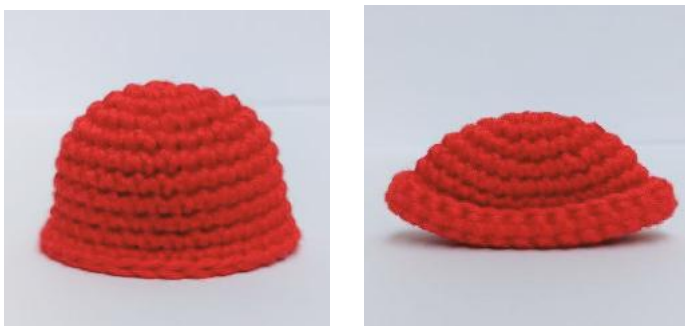
Rnd 4. [inc, 2 sc] x 6 (24)

Rnd 5. [3 sc, inc] x 6 (30)

Your piece might start curling - that's totally normal. For a neater final look, push the middle of your piece until it curves the other way. This makes the "right side" face out. Then keep crocheting to the left. If you're a lefty, keep crocheting to the right.

Rnds 6-11. 30 sc (30)

Invisible fasten off and weave in yarn tails. Fold the last two rounds of the beanie up on the outer side to form a rim at the bottom of the beanie.



POM-POM

Red yarn.

Cut a forearm's piece of yarn and set aside.

Step 1.

Wrap yarn around 2 fingers at least 15 times. Cut yarn.

Step 2.

Using the forearm's piece you set aside, double knot one side around the middle of the looped yarn. Leave a long tail.

Step 3.

Cut open all of the loops.

Step 4.

Trim the pom-pom into a tiny ball. Be careful not to trim the long tail.

Step 5.

Thread needle with long tail, and insert it in the middle of the top of the beanie, from the outside in.

Step 6.

Insert needle back into the pom-pom, and through the top of the beanie. Repeat at least 3 times to secure the pom-pom to the beanie.

Step 7.

Fasten off and weave in yarn tail.
