

# WOÖBLES TINY CAKE

# **SETUP**



- 1. 4mm crochet hook
- 2. Tapestry needle
- **3.** Pink medium-weight yarn, 33 yds, with 3 stitch markers in it
- 4. White medium-weight yarn, 2 yds
- 5. Yellow medium-weight yarn, 2 yds
- 6. Stuffing
- 7. Scissors (not included)

# **ABBREVIATIONS**

This pattern is written in US terminology, and crocheted in continuous rounds. Watch video tutorials at **thewoobles.com/tutorials** 

ch chain

sl st slip stitch

sc single crochet

inc increase (2 sc in the same hole)

dec (invisible) decrease

rnd round

blo back loop only

## **HOW TO READ A WOOBLES PATTERN**

round total number of stitches in the round

**Rnd 3.** [sc, inc] x 6 (18)

what stitches to do this round, and how many times

For round 3, repeat the pattern in the brackets 6 times. The pattern is: single crochet in 1 stitch, then increase stitch in the next stitch. Because an increase is actually 2 single crochet stitches in the same stitch of the previous round, the total number of stitches in this round is 18.

# **PATTERN**

### **CAKE**

With pink and white yarn.

Rnd 1. (pink yarn) start 7 sc in a magic loop (7)

To keep track of where you are, use a stitch marker to mark the beginning of each round, move the stitch marker to the first stitch of that round.

**Rnd 2.** 7 inc (14)

Rnd 3. [sc, inc] x 7 (21) Rnd 4. 21 sc blo (21) Rnd 5. 21 sc (21)

Your piece might start curling - that's totally normal. For a neater final look, push the middle of your piece until it curves the other way. This makes the "right side" face out. Then keep crocheting to the left. If you're a lefty, keep crocheting to the right.

Rnd 6. (switch to white yarn) 21 sc (21) Rnd 7. (switch to pink yarn) 21 sc (21)

**Rnd 8.** 21 sc (21)

**Rnd 9.** [sc blo, dec blo] x 7 (14)

Stuff the piece so that the top and bottom of the cake are flat.

Rnd 10. 7 dec (7)

Fasten off leaving a long tail. Thread a needle with the tail; then use it to pull the yarn tail through the front loops of each stitch. Pull tight to close the remaining gap and hide the tail.

# **FROSTING**

With white yarn.

#### **Top frosting**

#### Step 1.

SI st join the yarn in the last unworked front loop from round 4 of the cake. Insert the hook from the top to the bottom of the cake.

#### Step 2.

Ch 3, sl st in the same stitch as the sl st join.

#### Step 3.

[Ch 3, sl st in the next unworked front loop] x 19

#### Step 4.

Ch 3, sl st in the same stitch as the sl st join.

#### Step 5.

Fasten off and hide the yarn tail.











# **Bottom frosting**

Repeat steps 1-5 for the top frosting, but this time in the unworked front loops from round 9 of the cake.



With yellow yarn

**Rnd 1.** ch 5 (5)

Rnd 2. sl st, hdc, sc, sl st, ch 1. Rotate the piece to work on other side of the foundation chain. sl st, sc, hdc, sl st. sl st into the first stitch of round 2.

Fasten off leaving a long tail. Thread a needle with the tail; then use it to sew the flame to the center top of the cake.
